**Fr. Thomas P. Higgins**, 75, on June 9 in Los Gatos, Calif. He taught, coached golf, and was campus minister at Loyola Marymount University in Los Angeles.

**Fr. Robert L. Maloney**, 78, on August 19 in Los Gatos, Calif. He was a professor and administrator for many years at the University of San Francisco.

**Fr. Thomas J. Maloney**, 71, on July 11 in San Jose. He taught political science and served in administration at Loyola Marymount University in Los Angeles.

**Fr. David C. Schwartz**, 52, on June 8 in Jewell, Ore. He was the associate director at the Loyola Institute for Spirituality in Orange, Calif.

**Fr. Robert H. Taylor**, 89, on August 7 in Los Gatos, Calif. He taught in and chaired the philosophy department at Loyola Marymount University in Los Angeles.
