

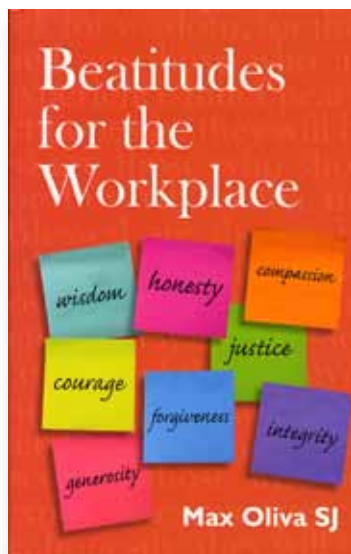

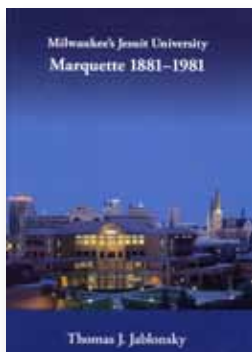
## SPIRITUALITY

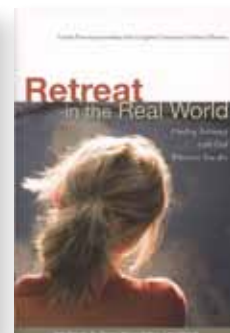
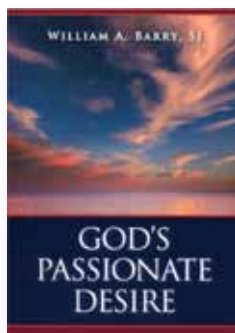

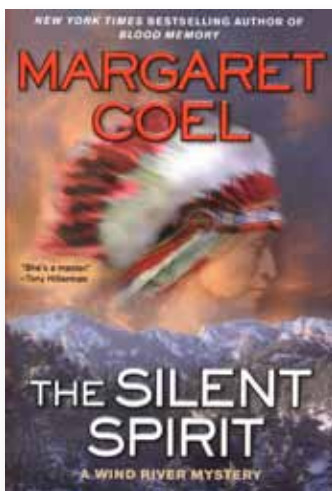
## PRAYER/RETREATS
